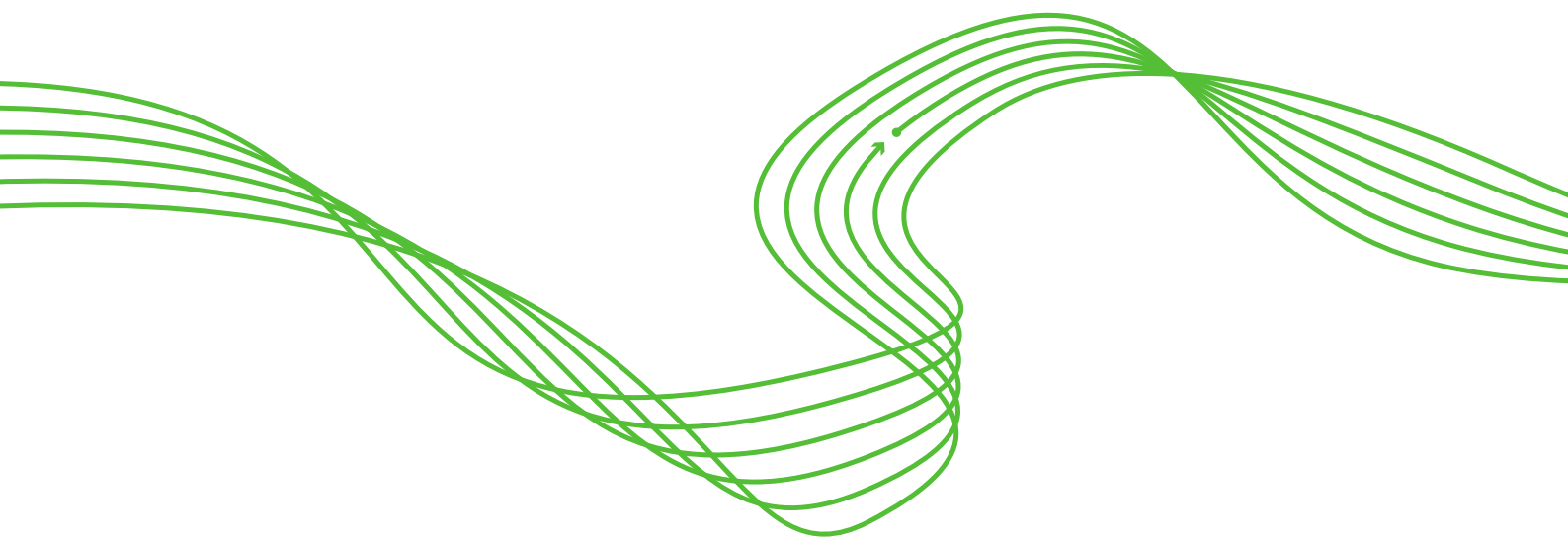

## Terms

The terms used in the Conformance Level information are defined as follows:

- **Supports:** The functionality of the product has at least one method that meets the criterion without known defects or meets with equivalent facilitation.
- **Supports with Exceptions:** Some functionality of the product does not meet the criterion.
- **Does Not Support:** The majority of product functionality does not meet the criterion.
- **Not Applicable:** The criterion is not relevant to the product.
- **Not Evaluated:** The product has not been evaluated against the criterion. This can be used only in WCAG 2.2 Level AAA.

## WCAG 2.2 Report

Tables 1 and 2 also document conformance with:

Notes: Orchestra is software with four distinct user interface (UI) types. All are browser-based.

The primary UI is generally kept in out-of-the-box or slightly modified form; this is the interface with staff members, which has a number of secondary types (e.g., Reception, Counter/Serving, Management, Admin). In preparing responses to the WCAG 2.2 criteria, Qmatic has identified these UIs with **Software**.

A second interface type is the screens used to interact with customers; these may appear on single-purpose kiosks or tablets, the customers' own mobile devices, or traditional web pages. These are almost exclusively process-driven pages guiding users through the steps to make an appointment, check in to a queue, identify the service(s) they have come to get, etc. The majority of these screens are configurable and configured to Qmatic's client's specifications. Thus, although Qmatic personnel are involved in the configuration effort and can to some extent influence the specifications, final decisions are beyond Qmatic's control.

The third UI type is a set of web-based screens within the Appointments module; these are served directly by Orchestra to Orchestra-generated web pages. For these pages, accessibility is within Qmatic's control. Any other content on web pages would be information provided by Orchestra but presented on client-defined web pages, and thus accessibility is out of Qmatic's control. The second and third UI types are considered **Web** interfaces for the purpose of the VPAT. Specific answers are limited to the small number of pages actually controlled by Orchestra; we offer more general information as to Orchestra's ability to support the standards elsewhere if our client chooses to follow accessibility guidelines.

Within Orchestra is a module called Surface Editor. This module is used to edit existing screens and create new ones as needed. Our reading of the WCAG 2.2 suggests this is essentially an **Authoring Tool**.

Finally, there are the **Electronic Docs**: User Guides, exported reports, configuration records, training materials, etc. The default format for these materials is PDF.

Orchestra has no **Closed** functionality.
